Hello Mike,

Our Effluent discharge to the recycled water application is shut down for scheduled maintenance and with the lagoons down low enough (10' and 4.5') we don't plan to resume recycled water application until the 9<sup>th</sup>. I am also scheduled to be off on the

10<sup>th</sup>, I would like to be able to be on site for your inspection, but of course Mitch Jaspers our lead operator I am confident can assist in any way needed as well.

As far as sampling goes because we are going to be getting things back into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> I don't think it would be the best day to conduct a sampling. Maybe the September 17<sup>th</sup> would be better? We still do not have a comp sampler at the effluent pump station so any sampling before river discharge would be grab samples collected by my operators every hour they are on shift. So we would get about 10-12 sample grabs for the composite sample.
