- Strawberry Park Update Lizz met with the Parks Counselor, Jody Newland, and artists Crystal Shenk and Shelby to discuss the opportunities April 14, 2023 and the artists are
- Report on Spring Clean-Up Efforts Friday: 14.86 Tons and 22 yards collected. 380 people on Saturday 38.42 tons of garbage, 560 yards. 29,330 lbs of scrap metal came in. No shredder this year. Drug take back day also happened. Received a \$20 donation and will be given to parks department. Molalla Sanitary/B&B Leasing donated their time and services. Will do this again next year around the same time.
- Flower Hanging Baskets Update Limited number of faucets and too late to do anything this year. FFA would need an order by October to meet the need in 2024. Would need building owners to pitch in and provide water supply. Josh Cramer works for an irrigation system. Pamela has invited him to join our committee. Flowers would only be able to added to the buildings but not the poles.
- Tree Lighting Update City has approved cover the cost of electricity for lighting the tree trunks. Lighting is 20"x45" \$20 each. Holiday Light Solutions in Oregon City. Rated for 60K hours. Would need volunteers to install. Need to count the trees to find out how many lights are needed. Connie will do the count and create a budget.
 - Cultural/Arts Grants Pre-planning Lizz will get a list of grants together with focus areas and maximum funding per grant. Possible projects: Utility box wraps, waste can holders, gateway signage, seating, light pole art, architectural design plan, signage. (Lizz ask City about whether he got a copy of this).
