RE: Celebrate Molalla: FUN-raising

Agenda presented to group, Carol (New to committee) started by sharing her thoughts and goals regarding City Parks:

- 1. Molalla needs to acquire more parks
- 2. Spend money to make money
- 3. Parks, ballfields, playground only a small part of what is needed in Molalla
- 4. City to focus on utilizing more empty spaces
 - a. Trails
 - i. Jody noted City has cleaned out trails where people were beginning to camp
- 5. Grants
 - a. Jody noted Celebrate Molalla is a start to fundraising, "buy in" before committee can access grants

Committee moved on to commenting on Celebrate Molalla:

- 1. Have copies of Chief Yelkus Bubbles from community
 - a. Those turned in by committee / schools
 - b. Carol mentioned to provide handouts with photos
- 2. Signage:
 - a. Maps
 - b. To Handouts
 - c. Thermometer

Idea brought up by Tina to possibly cut down some SDC's for incoming businesses as an incentive for those businesses to donate to parks; or some of those SDC's collected be donated to Parks Fund. Jody noted this would not be a wise decision to make. Further comments regarding a budget to acquire acreage to turn into parks, unfortunately no funds to do so.

Some members noted how much other city parks have to offer their communities. Molalla has open spaces – both City and School District should work together regarding parks and/or land usage. Additional comments from committee regarding difficulty to bring cohesiveness to City and School District referenced Molalla Pool as an example.

Betty mentioned Dog Parks: Wilsonville has a \$250 Fee for Dog Shows – these types of shows would bring in a lot of people to a possible fundraiser.

Emily reflected on the 'Tile Fundraiser', tile decoration to adhere to a wall, need to speak with architect as to how it would be sealed and adhered to wall. Possibly reaching out to Re-Stone in Canby for tile donations? Thought of possibly partnering with Library, Library may even be able to purchase said tiles

and they would set up craft day. Some disagreed noting Library events are lively. Further comments regarding sending flier home to community members and have the tile project be a "complete at home and return". It may be more difficult to attain an audience/group of people on a schedule date as opposed to sending items home and having parents return to another fundraising event.

Clark Park filed will worked on to be sloped, at some point raise money for Clark Park.

Rae noted to not forget about Ivor Davies Disk Golf, this group may be feeling left out as annexation into City has not been discussed as of late.

Jody would like to focus on Parks Fundraising rather than adding it to a City utility bill as a fee. Molalla works amazingly together, and people will be excited to get behind parks.

Reminder all projects will be sent to Council when funds need to be utilized. Chief Yelkus park is far from being 'paid for', much more fundraising to be done; especially when grant applications are being considered, community buy in will need to be a focus.
