Parks CPC Meeting 8/4/22 – Fox Park Discussion: Celebrate Molalla and Fundraising

Topics of Discussion: Celebrate Molalla and Fundraising

Booth at Celebrate Molalla

- o All in attendance agreed with having a booth if it was a possibility.
- o Raffle Prizes discussed
 - Raffle tickets cost to follow (Rebecca suggested 1/\$2.00, 3/\$5.00, 10/\$8.00 would still need to would out pricing)
 - Rebecca will be having a sale in efforts to raise money for softball and would pick through and see if there are any items or baskets CPC could use.
 - Crystal currently has two donors for raffle prizes
 - Betty mentioned she has a friend who embroiders and is sure she can obtain items to raffle off
- Rae messaged Leota Childress through FB Messenger and sent a text to ask for booth availability at Celebrate Molalla

Question was brought up by Rae regarding Non-Profit status. Suggested we would need to partner with local non-profit to secure Donation Receipts for local businesses interested in donating.

Rae mentioned some businesses would rather donation a sum of money than to donate items to our Celebrate Molalla cause. The Parks City Fund was mentioned and asked if community was able to donate into this fund – how are receipts obtained for donation? I informed Rae and rest in attendance I would follow up with Dan.

Partnering with a local non-profit brought a question by Rebecca, "What would be the Admin Fee for Fiscal Agent?" Rae noted it would be something to discuss with local non-profit.

Rae and Rebecca both asked what the money raised would be used for? Or where should the attention be placed? Suggested we should have a selling point in efforts to be more successful with fundraising.

We discussed Chief Yelkus Park as a selling point or additional work to be done at fox park. Also mentioned having a goals list and working funds by a list.

Rebecca noted there were different action items she was working on such as MYS Fields. Mentioned:

- Sheets Field
 - New drainage, outfield becomes a swamp
 - Mentioned Dan had previously noted there was already a plan in place.
 - Follow up?

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- Clark Parks
 - o Different field levels
- Separate committee for MYS Fields?
 - Rebecca already has donors in place and a large group interested in volunteering and moving on action items
 - Currently working on an MLB Grant for underserved communities.
- Dugout covers on Sheets Field noted this was a separate item

Moving back to Celebrate Molalla as a group we discussed the following Action Items:

- 1. Questions for Dan to help with:
 - a. How may CPC allocate Park CPC Funds
 - i. Is there a current goal?
 - ii. Should we discuss a goals list
 - iii. Need for a selling point for Celebrate Molalla (What are we fundraising for?)
 - b. City Parks Donation Fund (?)
 - i. How is community able to donate and receive receipts for donation?
 - c. Since two local Non-Profits in town have Council Members associated is there a conflict to team-up with either non-profit?
 - d. Signage / Posters / Handouts
 - i. Is this something City can assist with for booth at Celebrate Molalla?
- 2. Letter to local business for possible donation of items to raffle off at Celebrate Molalla
 - a. Gift cards
 - b. Merchandise
- 3. Confirm with Leota Childress for space availability at Celebrate Molalla
