### CALL TO ORDER

The Molalla City Council Meeting of August 10, 2022 was called to order by Mayor Scott Keyser at 7:00pm.

*A motion was made by Councilor Childress to approve the Consent Agenda, seconded by Councilor Robles. Vote passed 7-0, with all Councilors voting Aye.*

Mayor Keyser announced the following: “Prior to Regular Session this evening, an Executive Session was held. The session was held pursuant to Oregon Public Record Law, ORS 192.660(2):

- (e) To conduct deliberations with persons designated by the governing body to negotiate real property transactions.

*Council President Newland made a motion to authorize city staff to enter into real property negotiations for a two-million-gallon water tank, seconded by Councilor Vermillion. Vote passed 7-0, with all Councilors voting Aye.*

### ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS

- A. Ordinance No. 2022-03: Declaring a Ban on Psilocybin Service Centers and the Manufacture of Psilocybin Products  
(2<sup>nd</sup> Reading)

Community Development Director Corthell presented the staff report, explaining to council members the need for the second reading and adoption of Ordinance No. 2022-03.

City Recorder Teets shared data that Council had requested from the July 27, 2022, meeting. During the Work Session, the City Attorney mentioned 2020 voting results of Measure 109 in Molalla. Votes to pass the Measure totaled 1,186, votes against the Measure totaled 2,002.

*Councilor Vermillion made a motion to hold the second reading of Ordinance 2022-03 by title only and approve it for adoption. Seconded by Council President Newland. Vote passed 6-1. Voting Aye: Mayor Keyser, Councilor Vermillion, Councilor Shankle, Council President Newland, Councilor Robles, and Councilor Klein. Voting Nay: Councilor Childress.*

- B. Resolution No. 2022-15: Referring to the Voters of Molalla A Measure of Proposing the Prohibition of Psilocybin-Related Business from Operating Within the City

*A motion was made by Council President Newland to adopt Resolution No. 2022-15 by title only, seconded by Councilor Shankle. Vote passed 6-1. Voting Aye: Mayor Keyser, Councilor Vermillion, Councilor Shankle, Council President Newland, Councilor Robles, and Councilor Klein. Voting Nay: Councilor Childress.*

- Community Development Director Corthell shared the 2022 KATU Explore Report, highlighting Molalla. He also shared a Destination Ready campaign that is being introduced.


#### COUNCIL COMMUNICATION


- Councilor Vermillion shared the MRSD and Chamber of Commerce upcoming meeting dates.


#### ADJOURN
