The District is working to limit these vectors and also eliminate existing and prevent future breeding sources. The efforts utilized by the District will allow for full enjoyment of backyards and recreational facilities, as well as working conditions, and will protect public health.

The District's goals include reducing vectors and as a result reducing the likelihood of vector borne diseases. You can help accomplish this goal by reporting vectors to the District, educating yourself and others on preventive actions against vectors, and eliminate standing water on your property. Mosquito fish can be furnished by the District for ornamental ponds, unused swimming pools or animal drinking troughs. If you are being bothered by flies and mosquitoes, or if you want to prevent mosquitoes from breeding on your property, the District is just a phone call or click away.
