Comment 1: the City of Molalla agrees that this exception found in the draft should remain in the final versions of the general permit text: "EXCEPTIONS Facilities that do not land apply their biosolids and manage all wastewater solids by either disposal in a permitted landfill or transfer their solids to other permitted facilities for management will not be granted coverage under this general permit. Facilities that fall under this exception may be required in their assigned individual permit for the treatment facility to submit an annual wastewater solids report to DEQ for documentation."

Comment 2: in Section 4, Land Application, Table A1 under "Soil Rooting Depth and Substratum" it states that sites should have a "minimum rooting depth of 24-inches". This eliminates all crops normally grown on such land. Example, Maize grows at an average depth of 5.8 inches (14.9 cm) with its absolute deepest root fibers reaching 46.57 inches (118.3cm)*. The City of Molalla recommends The DEQ should consider adding to the Definitions: "rooting depth (Di) of an individual plant i is the deepest soil depth reached by the roots of an individual plant (i.e. maximum rooting depth) and lateral root spread (Li) as the maximum linear distance (one-sided) from the stem of an individual plant reached by its roots." Under this definition, the Table A1 text should read "maximum root depth of at least 24-inches".

<u>Comment 3</u>: Section 2 states that subsamples must be collected from the rooting depth of the crop being grown. The City of Molalla recommends the text specify "the average rooting depth".
